


Why should the world care?


- 3TG Tin, Tantalum, Tungsten, Gold
- Mined in conditions of war
- Covered Countries = DRC + 9 adjoining countries*

*Angola; Burundi; Central African Republic; the Republic of the Congo; Rwanda; South Sudan; Tanzania; Uganda, Zambia.

EU – The Conflict Minerals Regulation

(The EU regulation will directly apply to companies that import tin, tungsten, tantalum and gold minerals and metals into the EU, no matter where they originate)












ABB Supplier Code of Conduct / Compliance standards

1. Comply with the ABB Supplier Code of Conduct

ABB's Supplier Code of Conduct has been updated to include requirements specific to conflict minerals:

- "Implement a policy regarding conflict minerals and exercise due diligence to investigate the source of these minerals"
- Respond in a timely manner to ABB's requests for evidence of your compliance with these requirements"

2. Meeting compliance standards

Work towards ensuring that any conflict minerals contained in the products supplied to ABB do not originate from mines that support or fund conflict within the Democratic Republic of Congo and adjoining countries

Due Diligence

3. ABB High Risk Smelters Due Diligence

Work towards ensuring that any conflict minerals contained in the products supplied to ABB do not originate from mines that support or fund conflict within the Democratic Republic of Congo and adjoining countries or CAHRA countries (Conflict Affected High Risk Areas).

- How?
 - Undertake due diligence efforts
 - Establish company management systems
 - Identify and assess risks in the supply chain
 - Design and implement a strategy to respond to identified risks
 - Share detailed action plan to transition away form these smelters and a date by when the updated CMRT will be submitted.

- ☐ Suppliers will receive Corrective Action Plans with specific mention of High-Risk Smelters & Refiners and Actions to be taken once CMRT uploaded / provided to ABB.
- ABB requires our suppliers to take immediate action on these Smelters and Refiners (SOR's) which may mean working with your upstream suppliers.
- Consistent Follow-up will be made by ABB until these SOR's are transitioned away or definitive actions provided.



- Do NOT click reply to send CMRTs via email
- Do NOT edit subject line



Submitting CMRT via link

- Click the upload link (see below) in e-mail
- Step 1 Submitter Information
- Step 2 Upload the CMRT
- Step 3 Click Submit



Within a few minutes you will receive an email with feedback from the system.

If your CMRTs has errors, they MUST be fixed at the earliest.



Important Notes

Instructions to fill CMRT Declaration

- If you are unable to open the CMRT submission link
 provided in the invite, you can submit your CMRT via email
 @ global-conflictmineralscompliance@abb.com
- ABB only accepts CMRT above version 6.0
- Fill all the mandatory / Yellow fields in the CMRT.
- Only one email address can be provided in the E-mail contact
- Effective date in CMRT should belong to current reporting year (Jan 2024 to current date).
- If answer to question E is "yes, using other format", you are required to mention the format that you use in the comment section.

- If you need product details, send an email. We will reach out to our internal team and provide you the product list if available.
 Meanwhile we request you to submit a company level CMRT.
- If there is any company name change notify us by sending an email. Meanwhile, provide a CMRT with your current company name.
- If you are not the manufacturer of the products supplied/are a distributors, please collect CMRT from your suppliers and submit a consolidated CMRT under your company name.
- If you are unable to submit the CMRT in the given time frame, advise if the CMRT can be submitted before 15th of April. This will help us to work on action plans if any.
- If you are not the right contact for Conflict minerals in your organization, forward mail to the right contact and notify us.



Instructions to fill the Smelter List in the CMRT



Smelter List Data entry when Smelter ID is <u>Available in</u> <u>smelter look up</u>:

Input the smelter identification number in Column A (columns B, C, E, F, G, I and J will auto-populate); D will grey out.

Smelter List Data entry when Smelter ID <u>Not Available in</u> <u>smelter lookup</u>:

- Select appropriate metal in column B as shown in the below figure.
- 2. Next select smelter not listed in column C as shown in the below figure.
- 3. Once smelter not listed is selected then you will be requested to fill with smelter name and smelter country in column D & E.
- 4. Once the above is done put the smelter id in column F if available.
